Emergency Protocol Procedures

This protocol is in place for you to use if you encounter an emergency during the course of a Nederland Farmers Market.

In the case of any situation, always REMEMBER:

1. Stay CALM.
2. Use your resources (radio/cell phone, co-workers, other community members)
3. Perform only what you are trained to do.
4. One staff works with the patient, the other calms & supervises the rest of the group.
5. If the patient is in danger of loss of life, limb, or eyesight, immediately call 911.

It is better to call and turn away an ambulance than to wait.

If the situation is LIFE THREATENING (anaphylaxis, medical emergency, Diabetic

emergency, or any incident that results in a change in level of consciousness)

1. Remain CALM
2. Dial 911 and be prepared to give our location (listed at bottom of page)
3. Contact other staff and market vendors by radio, cell phone if not reachable.

If the situation is a NON LIFE THREATENING emergency, please follow these steps

1. Remain CALM
2. Inform market manager about location and situation

Examples of non-life threatening emergencies that would still require the lead naturalist are:

- Animal bites
- Immobilizing injury (serious sprain or strain)
- Severe cold/ frostbite
- Violent behavior or threatening language
- Suspicious person on site

Weather Emergencies

High Winds

- Anything exceeding 45+ mph (Beaufort Scale 6 or Higher– see attached map) calls for an immediate shutdown of the market. Vendors and market assistants must work quickly and safely to close down the market.
- An announcement will be made via PA system at the music tent to announce any closures. Additionally, a call will be made over the walkie talkies to spread word to vendors.
- Vendors must immediately cease sales as soon as the announcement about shut down has been made.
- Please follow the emergency action plan to get patrons, vendors, and staff to safety

Lightning

- Multiple lightning strikes within 15 miles of the market calls for a shut down. A call will be made over the walkies as well as an all market announcement over the PA system at the music tent. Once that announcement has been made all vendors must cease sales.
- Vendors and market assistants must work together to shut down the market efficiently and safely.
- Please follow the emergency action plan to get patrons, vendors, and staff to safety.

Shelter due to Weather

- If the winds, rain or storm is such that shelter is the best option these are the places you can seek out:
 - Salto (just east of the market off Snyder), Busey Brews (off E 1st. st)
 - Busey Brews (S. 1st st)
 - Decent Bagel (Pink building on parking lot)
 - Sweet Sues (White mercantile on N. 1st st)

Excessive Heat

- Any temperature exceeding 105 degrees calls for an immediate shutdown of the market.
- A call will be made over the walkies as well as an all market announcement over the PA system at the music tent. Once that announcement has been made all vendors must cease sales.
- Vendors and market assistants must work together to shut down the market efficiently and safely.
- Please follow the emergency action plan to get patrons, vendors, and staff to safety; seeking shelter is a good option here.

Active Shooter

- In the event of an active shooter, evacuate quickly in the opposite direction of the shooter.
- If evacuation is not possible, the next option is to hide in place (lock and barricade doors, hide under tables, seek safety around the buildings, stay as quiet as possible, wait for instructions).
- We hope that NFM never ever has to live out this scenario, but the reality is we must practice it and ensure that our staff and vendors understand these options.

Missing Persons/Child

- If a missing person or child approaches a vendor booth, please bring them to the Info Booth and an announcement will be made on the PA system at the music tent.

First Aid

- Should first aid be needed please bring the patron to the NFM Info booth.
- There is a first aid kit available at the Info booth.
